

A complete approach to home health care and overall recovery.

- We provide in-home skilled care when an individual experiences an acute onset or worsening of a condition.
- Our team coordinates with the patient, the patient's family, and the patient's physician in order to assure our patients receive the highest quality of care.

As part of our complete approach to care, we also provide:

- Education related to specific disease and injury processes, expanding individuals' (patient, family, friends, etc.) knowledge of what can be expected during the course of recovery.
- Nursing staff on call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- Referrals for additional beneficial services.
- A goal specific discharge plan created through close collaboration with patient, physician, and nursing staff to facilitate and support the continuation of the patient recovery process.



Complete home health services from your Pike County neighbors.

A physician's order for home health services begins the process. Services include:

- Skilled nursing care necessary for recovery from illness, including IV & IM therapy, wound care, diabetic foot care, in addition to many other physician ordered requests.
- A home health aide to provide assistance with bathing, hygiene and grooming.
- Medical social services to aid in addressing any issues interfering with patient recovery.
- Physical therapy to assist with mobility, including therapeutic exercise, in addition to balance, gait, and transfer training.
- Occupational therapy to help patients adjust and relearn activities essential to daily living.
- Speech therapy to address speech disorders as well as problems with swallowing, hearing and memory loss.
