The Pike County Health Department has four certified basic life support instructors through the American Heart Association and are proud to be able to offer these services to our community. These courses are open to the public (limited space available) and are held in our community conference room.

Heartsaver® First Aid - \$50

Heartsaver First Aid is a class room, video-based, instructor-led course that teaches students critical skills to respond to and manage an emergency in the first few minutes until emergency medical services (EMS) arrives.

Heartsaver® CPR AED - \$50

This classroom course teaches basic CPR skills such as performing a head tilt-chin lift and giving compressions and breaths. The course provides training for anyone who wants to learn basic CPR and obtain a Heartsaver course completion card, as well as education on the proper use of AED machines.

Basic Life Support (BLS) for Healthcare Providers - \$60

The BLS for Healthcare Providers - Classroom Course is designed to provide a wide variety of healthcare professionals the ability to recognize several life-threatening emergencies, provide CPR, use an AED, and relieve choking in a safe, timely and effective manner.
